I recently made the final preparation for shipping the container of English John and Romans to Yinka Fasinro in Nigeria, Africa. This container will cost approximately \$3950.00 to ship and is scheduled to arrive the first week of December. Bro. Yinka is very excited about receiving the container of scripture as he is looking forward to getting it into the hands of the people in Nigeria.

We will load the container of English to Nigeria on 4 Oct 2011 from my home church, Maranatha Baptist Church in Saint Robert, MO. Loading is scheduled at 2:00 p.m. We would like to invite you be a part of this shipment. As you know it takes a

couple hours to load the boxes of scripture into the container, filling it completely from front to back. It is such a blessing to have all the men and women there to help load the container and to participate in the dedication of the scripture as it heads to the mission field. If you would like to attend or participate in this shipment, we would love to have you. We will have lunch at 12:00 for those who are able to attend. Please let me know if you can make it so we can plan for enough food.
