grandbaby! Mike and Lynelle live in Elkton, South Dakota where they farm and serve the Lord in various children's ministries at First Baptist Church.

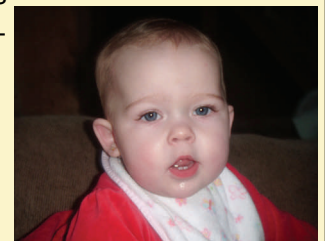
