Dear Pastors & Prayer Partners,

Greetings in the wonderful name our Lord Jesus Christ.

What a busy time it has been preparing to transfer the ministry over to Bro. Jim Waymire and Bro. Wayne Dinwiddie. Both men are working hard to ensure everything continues to run smoothly as I prepare for my deployment to Afghanistan by the end of this month.

Bro. Waymire is working diligently towards the shipment of Tamil for Bro. Banuel. This container will be shipped from Pastor Cofer's church, Trinity Hill Baptist Church in Norcross, Georgia on August 20th. Bro. Justus Banuel will be in the United States for this shipping and plans to be a part of the shipping of his container.

The churches in India have been without John

and Romans or tracts of any kind to pass out for over 6 months now. Bro. Banuel is praying that all goes as planned so they can have the scripture needed for his people. By the time they receive the container the first part of October it will be nearly one year without the Gospel of John and Romans to hand out to the people of India. I sincerely pray this kind of time lapse between shipments does not happen again. I have seen what happens to churches that fail to knock doors and hand out tracts or the Word

Please pray for Bro. Dinwiddie as he labors in this ministry. I have laid a lot on his shoulders as I transition to military duty on June 18th. He is doing a fine job and has a heart dedicated to the Lord's work.

We greatly appreciate the funds we have received towards the paper fund. We currently have the money needed to ship the container of Tamil for Bro Banuel in August. Funds have also been raised to ship the container of Runyancore to Uganda upon its completion. We presently have \$6500.00 towards the purchase of our next truckload of paper. PRAISE THE LORD!

Approximately \$900.00 is being received on a monthly basis toward printing and paper expenses. At this rate it will take an additional 9 months before we can purchase the next truck load of pa-

per. Would you consider giving a love offering towards this truckload of paper or consider taking on the paper fund for monthly support?

I know this has been a very discouraging time waiting for press repairs and an extended period of time without work. Please pray that the press will be up and running soon. This is the longest our seedline churches have been without work. I pray that this will find our workers anxious to get back to work and seeing the need for the Gospel around the world.

By the time you receive this letter I will have already started my active duty time with the US Army. I have duty in Ft. Benning, GA for a few days prior to my departure to Afghanistan on June 25th. Originally my team was not scheduled to deploy to Afghanistan until late July, however, the government moved the "in country date" by a month so our team can get to work on housing and facilities that are in great need due to the "Surge" that is taking place in Afghanistan. I will be working out of Kabul,

Afghanistan in the Military Basing and Facilities Office which supports the geographic regions. I will be over what is called RC-South which is the southern part of the country to include Marjah and Kandahr. Pray for the team as we design and build military bases in support of the efforts in Afghanistan.

It is my desire to see souls saved in Kabul as I intend to start a Bible study with the military folks there. I enjoyed how the Lord allowed these opportunities in 2006-2007 while deployed to Afghanistan. So many of our military soldiers need the Lord as their Saviour. I look forward to the chance to witness to them and provide regular Bible studies.

I ask that you pray for my family and the ministry during my deployment. We are all "members of the Body of Christ" and have specific tasks to accomplish. May we each do our part over the next year to ensure God's word continues to go forth to a lost a dying world.
