This machine was delivered to one of our Seedline churches, Crossroads Baptist Church in Girard, KS. Crossroads Baptist Church has volunteered to operate this Glue Binder for future books, John and Romans and New Testament projects. This will further our outreach for prison ministries as many prisons will not allow stapled booklets in their facilities. It will also increase our capabilities for the mission field and churches across the United States in reaching souls with the Printed Page.

We made it safely to Mongu yesterday, had a great service, then on to Sioma to the Barotse Royal Establishment to see Senior Chief Lukama, IV.

We had a wonderful time this afternoon with the Chief, presenting him with a leather bound "Church" King James Bible, which was kindly sent to us by Bro. Samuel Martin. He was very touched and grateful. He has a clear testimony of salvation, and God is opening an Amazing Door here through him in two districts!

After spending several hours with the Chief today, during which time we discussed a plan to preach and reach the village here where his palace is, then on into Sioma and Shangombo districts, we then were able to start sharing the Gospel with the Chief's nephew, who is like an assistant to him.

Please pray for Sifuniso (See-fu-nee-so), that God brings true conviction. He had to go, but wants to continue the Bible study tomorrow.

We are excited for our Missions Conference. We love to be derful words from a hymn that I often love to sing. I certainly know part of a Missions Conference, whether it is in our church or another that the Lord is leading, guiding and directing this ministry and your church. Always, the conversation centers around getting the Word of efforts as we partner together in getting scripture to the mission field. I also know that God's Word will not return void as I receive reports from the mission field of those who have been saved and of men surrendering to pastor churches in villages which didn't have the Gospel prior to the scripture arriving.

Barbara and I were able to spend a little time with our daughter, Lynelle and family in South Dakota during the month of September. My how our five grandkids in South Dakota are growing and changing! Time passes so quickly.

During our time in South Dakota we presented the ministry to a new church and I was also able to deliver a hydraulic paper cutter to two of our Seedline churches in Sioux Falls and Elkton, SD. The hydraulic cutters replaced some very old manual cutters. I'm sure this will greatly help these two Seedline churches.

Bourg Perfect Glue Binder machine in Grand Rapids, MI that was given to the ministry. Praise the Lord! We then delivered the glue binder to a Seedline church in Kansas so it can be setup for binding John and Romans booklets. The glue binder will help further our outreach for Prison and Jail ministries as many of the prisons and jails will not allow stapled books into their facilities. We are so thankful for this capability and look forward to what the Lord has in store for this expansion of the ministry.

On October 8th, unfortunately, a tow truck pulled out in front of me as I was on my way to deliver a cargo trailer full of John and Romans

covers. This resulted in me totaling our 2016 F450 truck. Praise the Lord I was not injured in the accident and Barbara was not with me. However, this has certainly set me back on delivering scripture to our Seedline Churches. Please pray that I can get the insurance settled quickly and a replacement truck so we can keep



things going. We have already been three weeks without a truck. We are trying not to become impatient as we know that it is all in God's timing. Meanwhile, I will have to depend on churches to transport some of their own scripture until this is settled. Thank you to the churches who have mentioned the finances to help with trailer repairs and truck replacement.

As most of you are aware, November and December is our annual "Paper Drive" campaign. The paper fund has basically been depleted with the printing of 520,000 scriptures in Chichewa and Tamil languages. We have also recently paid for shipping the container to Sri Lanka. We have two more upcoming shipments to pay for on October 18 for India and November 6 for Africa. Your support will not be wasted but will reach many souls for Christ.

God to the lost world, and that is exactly what we have been doing for the past 36 years! Raising money in hundreds, yea, thousands of churches across America to help missionaries have the Scriptures in whatever language they need so they can reach the lost with God's precious Word wherever they are at! Amen! We are excited to have physically helped with loading the container of 300,000+ John-Romans in the Tamil language going to India, where there is such a hunger for the gospel.

We have been "on the road" and gone from Festus for six months, and some days it seems like a year! It is a time of rejoicing to reunite with our church family. God is so good to give us Christian family wherever we go. We were in many good churches on this last trip presenting the ministry and the needs; a few camp meetings where the preaching always challenges us and refreshes our spirits, and a couple of fantastic mission conferences! Praise the Lord.
