## SEEDLINE WORK

What a great time we had for three days in August with Pastor Mike Buckamneer and the folks of Crossroads Baptist Church in Girard, KS. Pastor Jeff Quigley along with eight people from Smoky Valley Baptist Church joined us for three days of working Scripture in the print shop. Smoky Valley Baptist Church was interested in seeing how the Scripture ministry works.

We completed 9,200 John/Romans in Spanish and Chichewa and printed and folded 18,200 English covers during our time together. A lot of work was accomplished and we enjoyed the great fellowship literally around God's Word. Crossroads Baptist Church were great hosts. We are so thankful for Seedline churches who are willing to share the Scripture ministry with others.



WMBPS has printed over 16 million Scripture portions and sent them to missionaries overseas and to struggling and/or new church plants here in the United States. We currently have 31 seedline churches that help to make this possible.



### What is a Seedline Church?

WMBPS Seedline is local churches who has hands on involvement with publishing the Word of God. This is made possible by taking the printed page, collating it, placing the cover on the Scripture, stapling it, cutting the Scripture and boxing them for the mission field.

## SEEDLINE TESTIMONIES

In the Fall of 1993, our church, Believers Baptist Church in Winona Lake, IN, began its own Bearing Precious Seed ministry. We started with hand cutters and hand staplers in the back of our church auditorium. As we went forward, the Lord provided printing equipment such as offset presses to print covers, hydraulic cutters to trim the Scriptures and nice electric staplers. Over time, the Lord provided a large warehouse, which we call our Scripture Barn, along with more bigger equipment enabling us to speed up the process in doing John/Romans and New Testaments. Over the past nearly 26 years, we have had the privilege of doing well over two million John/Romans and New Testaments in 15 different languages. On August 16, 2019, we broke ground to build a new addition designated for collating Scriptures. The students and staff ladies from Hephzibah House do most of the collating for our BPS projects.

It has been an honor and privilege to be a part of Bible printing ministry for the past 26 years! Lord willing, by God's grace and provision, we are looking forward to the next 25 years. The need for spreading the precious seed of God's around the world is greater than ever. The current population of the world is over 7.5 billion souls. As Bible believing churches partner together, we can get the job done that God has given us to do--before the rapture of the Saints-- of reaching every tongue and people and nation (Revelation 5:9) with the Gospel through the printed page. We are also delighted to partner with the brethren at World Missions Bearing Precious Seed to help do Scripture projects.

## THE 10-40 WINDOW

The 10/40 Window is the area of the world between latitudes 10 degrees and 20 degrees North of the equator in the Eastern Hemisphere, covering North Africa, the Middle East and Asia. Two-thirds of the world's population is located in the 10/40 Window. In the areas of the 10/40 Window, there is only one missionary for every one million people.

60% of the world's population lives in the area yet it receives less than 20% of our missionary labor and 10% of our missionary dollars. 66,000 people in "the window" die every day, 46 every minute.

In 1986, Coca-Cola claimed that 97% of the world had heard of their product, 72% had seen it, and 51% had tasted it. Corporations are willing to invest more for marketing their product than Christians are for sending the Gospel.

- In Hinduism, 33 million gods are worshiped, and 200 million cows are considered holy.
- One third of the Earth's population is under the age of 15.
- It is estimated that 120 million people are presented with the Gospel for the first time each year.
- Over 1.1 billion people live on less 1 US dollar per day.
- There are at least 2,000 languages that still need the Bible translated.
- There are 230 million people who identify themselves as atheist.

The container of Parallel English and Chichewa Gospels arrived the end of July in Zambia. A cyclone wiped out other ports along the eastern African continent making Dar Es Salaam port busier than usual. This also affected the trucking capabilities. Praise the Lord, the container arrived safely. Please pray for the souls who will be receiving these Scriptures.

The funds to print the Thai Scripture has been raised. The covers are being printed as we speak and the press should start printing the signatures any day now. By the middle of September our Seedline churches should start receiving this Scripture for collation.

Many other Seedline churches are finishing up the Tamil for two separate shipments in October and November. With this said, many churches will soon be out of work. After the printing of the Thai, our funds will be depleted once again. This is a continual process in raising funds for paper. If your church does not support the paper fund, please consider taking this on for regular monthly support. You cannot go wrong with supporting the printing of God's Word!

We spent much of the summer months close to home helping with camps, the printing of personalized John and Romans and catching up on doctor and dental appointments. We also enjoyed visiting churches in Missouri and Kansas.

We were blessed that Barbara had the opportunity to spend a week with our daughter, Steffenie and her husband Kevin in Oklahoma City in June. Our son Michael and wife Amy stopped to see us in Missouri in August. We enjoyed a nice time celebrating Michael's birthday and two of his daughters. Emma turns 4 soon and Charli just turned 2. We are anxious to spend some time with our daughter Lynelle, husband Mike and their five children while visiting churches in South Dakota in September.

With summer coming to a close, we have a full schedule this fall. We will be putting many miles on the road as we attend missions conferences, Bible focus Sundays, and the distribution of Scripture. We will also begin the gathering of the Tamil Scripture for the two upcoming shipments.

We are still encouraging folks and churches to help us print the Arabic whole Bible. This is a tremendous testimony because we have had folks tell us of our (ChurchKJV.com) top quality leather Bibles that they have used faithfully for 15-18-20 years or more and they were still holding up well. To God be the Glory that this woman read her Bible so much that she had actually nearly worn it out!

We have done quite a bit of travelling this summer, even spending three weeks in a very HOT Texas. For His Glory! We will begin our "Fall travels" before you receive this letter. 
We are always in need of funds for paper. It costs approximately 25 cents to get one John and Romans on the mission field. Coin offerings are a great way to raise paper money!

## FROM THE MAILBOX

Dear Dennis,

I greet you in the name of our Lord and Saviour who has helped us every year until this very moment. Sunday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, I spoke at our conference in Seattle, Washington. Standing before me was a kind woman holding a frayed Bible in her hands. I recognized it as one of ours, its soft cover was torn with crumpled corners, her penned-in notes, highlighting nearly every verse, were smeared in places. "May I see it?" I asked. "This is my weapon of warfare," she said, handing it over. "Be careful."

As I held those well-worn, well-loved Scriptures in my hand, she told me her story. "I had gone to church all my life back home in Iraq, following crazy teaching, never having gotten ahold of the Word of God. But about six years ago, a pastor presented me with this and said, "This book has the great answer to all your questions." I read the first four chapters of the Gospel of John and felt the Holy Spirit speaking to me. Without thinking too much, I phoned the pastor. "Is it true," I asked, "that Christ is God appearing in the flesh? Is He the one who hung on the cross for me?" **"He that believeth on him is not condemned,"** the pastor shared from John 3:18, **"but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."** He prayed with me, since that time until now I have loved Him! He is my Lord and my Saviour! He is my husband, my children, my whole life!! I praise God with Isaiah: **'I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels'"** (61:10).

"Praise the Lord for the choice you've made," I said. "Would you like to have a new Bible besides this one?" "Yes and no," she replied. "I have read this one six times, sometimes spending five or six hours in it, just reading and praying and praising the Lord in Aramaic."

Not only was I privileged to speak with this sister (and I promised to send her a new Bible with a hard cover and wider margins), but I was honored to baptize her over the weekend along with two others, one a pastor also from Iraq and another believer from Egypt.

This conference made me more emotional than any other. What a blessing to minister to and be ministered to by these believing men and women from the NW corner of the US and the Vancouver area. God is moving there. We trust His hand to be on us as we host another conference in Wichita, Kansas.

Thank you for all you are doing for this ministry through financial and prayer support, and for all you are doing for the Kingdom of God. Pray for the believers who attend conferences, like these, that not only will they get a hold of the Word of God—through Gospels, NTs, and tracts in the Arabic language—but that the Word of God and the Spirit of God will lay hold of them as well.
