The Bibles were uncovered and some were pretty rough. Samuel suggested the possibility of using them to experiment with on the hot glue binder. After looking the Bible's over briefly I thought these were too good to cut up and experiment with.

I began to pray and ask God's leading as to what we could do with these Bibles. I recollected that many foreign countries speak English or at least have some people that can speak English and that these Bibles could be a great use to them. I got the idea that it would be a good thing to put covers on the Bibles and send them to a foreign country, perhaps Africa.


I talked to Samuel Martin about sending them to Africa and he seemed to think it was a good idea. I talked to my Pastor, Mike Buckamneer and he seemed to think it was a good idea too.

I sat one day down to take inventory of the books on the pallet. It turns out there were over a hundred very nice Thompsons chain Bibles with concordance and maps and a good number of other Bibles, a total of 177. As I handled the Bibles and looked at the various flaws and blemishes that had caused them to be rejected, I noticed specific notes describing the flaws and the very pages on which those flaws were located. And then I saw a note on one of the Bibles, actually the only one that had this

note on it, and it said quote "reject /Bibles for Africa". This simply was God's way of confirming the decision that had already been made.

THAI NEW TESTAMENTS FOR THAILAND

One of our Seedline Churches has recently completed approximately 7,500 of the 20,000 Thai New Testaments requested by

Missionary Curtis Hall. These New Testaments will be sent to Thailand along with the Thai John and Romans that is currently being worked by many of our Seedline Churches.

We will be loading a tractor trailer load with the first of the completed Thai as part of Maranatha Baptist Church's mission's conference in St. Robert, MO on July 14th.

Bro. Hall has a great support team in Thailand who is focusing primarily on the area of Bangkok which has a population of **10,539,415**. Bangkok has grown by 1,136,644 just since 2015 so you can imagine the need for Scripture in Thailand.

The need is great! Thank you to everyone who has prayed, given and worked to make projects like this one possible.

UPCOMING SHIPMENT

We are excited about an upcoming shipment of John & Romans, Bibles, study material and Sunday School material that we will be helping Pastor James Ruckman and Falls International Baptist Church in Sioux Falls, SD ship the middle of September. This container will be shipped to Ghana, West Africa. This will be a joint effort with several other ministries helping to make this possible.



The Lord is doing a tremendous work through Pastor Ruckman and Falls International Baptist Church with an outreach into West Africa. They are seeing souls saved both in their community and in West Africa.

MAINTENANCE, MAINTENANCE

It's never a dull moment with the kind of ministry we are in. With 35 Seedline Churches, you can imagine the hours spent hauling Scripture from the press to Seedline Churches and then picking it up from Seedline Churches in preparation for shipments. Our Seedline Churches cover eleven different states. Many miles are put on our truck and trailers resulting in worn out tires, brakes, shocks, rusted fender wells, worn out trailer doors and walls. With the truck and trailers required for this ministry it covers a total of 26 tires between \$300.00—\$490.00 a piece due to the heavy loads that we haul. On average, we replace tires every two years so you can see the expense required to do this ministry. We recently had shocks and tires put on our truck which is the most expensive of any of the tires. Our ministry requires more than the printing, collating, and shipping of Scrip-



ture. Although the Scripture is the most important part of the ministry there is a lot of behind the scene maintenance and repairs to keep the ministry going.

We praise the Lord for His hand of protection and provision as we travel up and down America's highways. Believe me when I say that America does NOT have the smoothest roads!

Thank you to those who support us through our work fund as your support keeps this ministry going.

India Update, June 2020



The past three months has been very difficult for Calvary Baptist Foundation. As a result of the COVID-19 virus, India has been hit very hard. Just like the United States, the government has put many restrictions on the people, but even to a greater extent. This has caused serious issues with the people's ability to work, shop for food, gather required materials for daily life, as well as meeting for church services. The India government has shut everyone and everything completely down.

In communicating with Bro. Andrew, he has stated that as a doctor he has been extremely busy taking care of those inflicted with COVID-19. He mentioned that many have died as a result of the virus, but severe complications led to many people starving to death on a daily basis since food was not available. Starvation has also affected the churches and their congregations. Pastors have not been allowed

to visit congregants or assemble so they lack funds to purchase food and needed supplies. Bro. Andrew has expressed the lack of financial assistance to meet the needs of the pastors and churches during this difficult time. He requested that I mention the dire need for additional support.

I greatly appreciated the phone calls from those voicing concern for Bro. Andrew and the people of India since the last news-letter. It is a blessing to assist Andrew and Calvary Baptist Foundation. Every phone call is encouragement that people care and desire to see this great work continue in reaching lost souls in India. This country is the largest population that is still open to the Gospel of Jesus Christ although the government is trying to do away with Christianity reduce it's effectiveness and outreach. Every stream of support is an investment in these precious souls for Jesus Christ.

Please continue praying and supporting the efforts of Calvary Baptist Foundation. This ministry receives \$930.00 a month from supporting churches and people who choose to support the ministry personally. This is a drastic decrease from what they used to receive.

A few weeks ago we had the privilege to set up a new seedline church, Heartland Baptist Church in Perryville, Missouri. The people of Heartland Baptist Church has supported the Scripture ministry for quite a few years but it is exciting to see them get started hands-on in the ministry. It is churches like this one that keeps the press running and seedline churches working. I know this ministry will be a real blessing to this church as they assemble the Word of God for lost souls.

With the effects of the "stay in place" or "quarantine" and the cancelation of all of our meetings we have helped with several projects around our home church. Our church has a youth camp that needed a new boys dorm and many other tasks to update the camp. Many of the projects were completed just in time for camp to take place. We seen three precious souls saved during camp this year. We pray that many young people's lives will be changed as a result of the camp.

Even amidst the Covid19 ordeal we were able to keep meetings in

South Dakota during the month of April. Although the "stay in place" orders were implemented, I was able to video tape or livestream services for several churches. We were also able to attend service at Big Sioux Baptist Church in Flandreau, SD. We enjoyed our time with all of the churches.



During our time in South Dakota we were able to visit our oldest daughter and family. We met our newest grandson, Russell Phillip Pankonin born April 13th weighing 9 lbs. 11 oz. and 23 inches long! He was a big boy but we praise the Lord that Mama and baby are both doing fine.

> I just spoke to one of the men that helps to collate much of our Spanish Scriptures for Mexico. Their church has been very involved for many years and it is a great blessing to know that they are still excited about serving the Lord in this capacity. Their church folks gather together a couple times a week and put together the Word of God in Spanish. This time is preceded by prayer and accompanied by fellowship. What a blessing and an encouragement that can be. And, the end result is that another 100,000 PLUS souls will get the Word of God in their language. We are also preparing to do the same in other languages with many other churches helping us. God is so good and His people are more than READY to jump back into this great work. Pray for more paper money. Always our greatest need. (And, thank you, for those who have recently sent money for paper to help with these projects!)

> Last week, I answered the call to again help with printing another 3,000 to 5,000 Arabic Whole Bibles. We are praying the Lord will provide the money to do the larger number, as the need in America is so great. Sometimes, we think only of the Muslims, and do not realize the great number of sold out, Christian Arabs needing a full copy of the Word of God. They are truly soul-winners among their people. And, they can reach great numbers of souls that we cannot. Matthew 4:16 says, "The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up."


