253,955 English John and Romans along with 3,960 New Testaments, and 197 whole Bibles were loaded in a container for Missionary James Ruckman at his home church, Eastside Baptist Church in Sioux Falls, SD. This container is on its way to Ghana, Africa. Falls International Baptist Church, a new church that Bro. Ruckman is planting for many of the African refugees in the Sioux Falls area helped to load the container. One of the men who helped load the container was a Muslim who had just been saved the day before. Praise the Lord!

UPCOMING PROJECTS, TRAVELS, PRAYER REQUESTS AND TESTIMONIES

Samuel Martin Update:

Blessed is the Word of the Lord. Many times leaders in the Bible made similar statements. It has and always will be TRUTH and as Christians we should say it and propagate it as the Truth it is.

What a blessing to ship our 69th container. The loading of this container was especially momentous for me as we loaded the container on September 11, 2020 from the parking lot of Eastside Baptist Church in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. This church is where I met Bro. William Byers, the man who presented the need for a helper in September 2000 and the Lord called me into the ministry. I could easily fill this newsletter with LOTS of memories from years ago but let me just say, "Blessed is the Word of the Lord"!!! What a privilege and honor it is to print and send Scriptures around the world.

This container was loaded for Missionary James Ruckman, Sr. who is planting Falls International Baptist Church in Sioux Falls, SD. Bro. Ruckman raised the money to ship this container so all I did was provide the Scripture and the logistics for getting the container loaded and on it's way to Ghana, Africa. We loaded the container with 253,955 English gospels and 3960 New Testaments, and 197 whole Bibles. Many other items were loaded as well such as study and Sunday School material, a tent and a generator to help with the ministry in Ghana. What a blessing to provide God's Word to the folks in Ghana, Africa. We had a great time loading the container, lots of helpers and great conversation with many of the folks reminiscing of all the years of Scripture ministry. The people at Eastside Baptist Church were excited to help and see what the Lord has been doing through the ministry for the past 19 years.

On September 7 and 8 I was at a missions conference at Colonial Baptist Church in Rogers, Arkansas. As you know we are working up 980,000 Thai scriptures in the seedline churches, but at this conference I met other missionaries who requested Scriptures for their ministries. Bro Hoffman in Nigeria requested English, and Bro. Hall requested English for Philippine churches. So what does this mean? We need to raise the funds, print, and work up about 600,000 English Gospel of John and Romans along with the other requests. Pray with us concerning this need, but please give so we can start filling these requests.

Most seedline ministries are up and running. Some never shut down, while others were required to do so. Through all of this I have been praying that God's work will continue. Praise the Lord for the Faithful workers who make the efforts to continue working Scriptures. God's Word will not return void, it will accomplish that which HE pleases. We must do all we can to get THE WORD to those who have never heard! Thank you for making this ministry a priority and finding ways to work on the Scriptures that are so badly needed. Those who are saved as a result of your faithfulness will testify in heaven of the importance of receiving it.

Dennis Deneau Update:

I can't tell you all how much I have appreciated your love and your prayers. I have finally finished my 36 weeks of Cardiac Rehab, and although my weight lifting restrictions have not been lifted for another three months, much of my everyday life has returned to normal. My wife, Lee, has had her knee replacement the first week of September and is doing quite well. She got her stitches out last week and will begin community Physical Therapy this coming week. We are still having some health struggles, but God has been very close through it all. Amen.

I am hoping that it will not be too long before we can be back on the road some, and having meetings in churches and continuing to raise money for paper on which to print the Word of God. I am thankful for all that the Lord has allowed me to do during this time, and I have been able to keep up on some communication with preachers and missionaries by phone, trying to encourage folks in the work of the Lord. Some things slowed during the "Covid", but God has been doing remarkable things as well. The 21,000 Thai New Testaments began assembly a little later than originally expected, but what an encouragement to get pictures on my phone of those involved in beginning that arduous task for His Glory and for lost souls in Thailand!

I am excited for the recently printed 25,000 English New Testaments that are currently being assembled. The Lord allowed us to partner with an evangelist and most of those will be used in America and many of them will find their way into public schools. God has greatly opened doors in many areas for this to happen. Pray for the young people that will receive these King James New Testaments; that their lives would be forever changed for God's Glory!

Watching the slanted news in America can be discouraging even to a Christian, and we NEED to pray for our country. But, keep your focus on Jesus. I Sam. 30:6, "...but David encouraged himself in the Lord his God." Daniel 2:21 says of God that, "...he removeth kings, and setteth up kings..." Yes, we need to pray for our country and for our election, but God already has His plan set into action. Folks are getting saved and being added to the Church at an amazing rate. Many areas of the world are seeing great numbers of souls being saved. We certainly must pray for America, but we also need to pray for India, Thailand, Africa, etc. as they receive the Word of God that folks like you are helping to send to them. The Truth of the Word of God is greatly affecting these countries.

Please pray about sacrificing any amount and sending in a monthly gift for paper to print the Scriptures to reach these hungering souls. Consider, also, in your personal lives, freely giving out tracts and Scripture portions (i.e. John-Romans) to the many fearful, lost souls who are searching for even a little bit of Truth. So many are confused during these times and are actually seeking answers. God's Word has the answers and they need only receive this Gift of Hope.

India Update, October 2020



As you can imagine, the COVID-19 virus continues to take it's toll on India. Andrew has expressed an extremely busy schedule taking care of sick ones due to the COVID virus. He continues to mention finding people along the roads who have died from starvation or sickness. Many times he has requested funds to assist pastors due to lack of offerings and not being able to assemble. Andrew has taken some of the financial support already designated for the purchase of food to distribute to the pastors in very poor areas. Praise the Lord for those who have sent funds to assist with these efforts.



Andrew is requesting another container of John and Romans. The last container arrived in January and it was distributed prior to the beginning of the COVID pandemic. Many people have called local pastors to discuss salvation over the phone since they

can not meet in churches. Praise the Lord for all those who have received Jesus Christ by this method. It was a

blessing to hear that some of the restrictions have been lifted and pastors have been able to make follow-up visits concerning people who have questions about salvation and the Scripture they have read from the John and Romans they received. Please continue to pray that many will come to know the Lord as their Saviour.

Churches have begun to assemble once again but there is still fear among the people so the congregations have been much smaller. Praise the Lord people are still accepting the Lord as their Saviour and following in believers baptism.

We can currently purchase a container of paper for \$11,200.00. Paper prices are nearing the lowest I have seen in 20 years of ministry. 


PERSONALIZED JOHN AND ROMANS


