TWENTY YEARS OF MINISTRY!



September 1st we celebrated 20 years in the ministry! As we look back, we have so many memories over the last 20 years. We just praise the Lord for all HE has allowed us to accomplish in the printing, promoting and propagating of HIS WORD to millions around the world. We have literally reached multitudes with the Gospel through the Printed Page!

When we first began in the ministry twenty years ago, I looked forward with anticipation in to allow the Lord to work and direct this great ministry through me. The Lord saw fit to allow us to cross paths with William and Ginny Byers who introduced us for the first time to the printing ministry. Little did we know at the time that the Lord would call Bro. Byers home to be with Him just a short 19 months after meeting

him, leaving the ministry he had started in my hands. I often think of Bro. Byers and wonder just what he thinks of the ministry now. I'm sure he's met many a soul who has been saved as a result of World Missions Bearing Precious Seed. I'm thankful for a man and his faithful wife who spent 15 years doing the hardest part in getting the ministry off the ground.

We have been blessed over the years with the cooperation that has come from our supporting churches, both in finances and Seedline work. The Lord has blessed and grown this ministry more than I could have ever imagined. For that, I am eternally grateful.

When we first started in the ministry on September 1, 2001, I had just come off of 15 years of active duty in the Army. Our family went from a guaranteed monthly income of an Army officer to a promised \$350.00 a month support. We had very little support for a family of five, let alone the needed support for printing Scripture. But, we saw first hand evidence of the Lord's provision. We prayed— in shoes for our children and saw the Lord provide for truck repairs that cost thousands of dollars. We struggled to ship just one container of Scripture a year, mostly going to Bro. Justus Banuel in India. Bro. Banuel is with the Lord now but he was very instrumental in distributing the Scripture to multitudes in India. Today, we are printing millions of Scriptures annually, shipping 4-5 containers a year going to over 28 countries of the world. We have grown from eight Seedline churches to forty-five.

Over the years we have had good men take on the burden of the ministry, standing up to help in many areas. Bro. James Waymire has been a huge blessing, standing in the gap when I was deployed two different times to Afghanistan. Bro. Waymire has also traveled thousands of miles to help raise funds for paper and shipping. He has been a tremendous mentor and help for many years. It was Bro. Byers who actually put us together saying, "if there is anyone you can truly trust for guidance and advice in the ministry, it was Bro. James Waymire." It has certainly been proven to be true.

Bro. and Mrs. Dennis Deneau joined our ministry in 2016 helping to raise funds for paper. They also helped expand the ministry working hand-in-hand through Church Bible Publishers, providing whole Bibles to prison ministries, new church plants and national pastors overseas. The Deneaus have been a real blessing and a great asset with a real burden for God's Word. We have built a real friendship with the Deneaus. We appreciate their labors in the Lord's work.

Over the last three years, Bro. Miles Wallis from Talking Rock Road Baptist Church in Branson West, Missouri has come on board helping with hauling and transporting Scripture from the press to Seedline churches. He has been a tremendous help in preparation for container shipments as well. The use of his semi truck and trailers has filled a great need in a growing ministry. He's a younger man with the strength and ability to handle pallets of Scripture as my body just isn't able to do the heavy work that it once did. God knew we needed a man like Bro. Wallis!

Even more recently, Bro. Tom and Jane Burch joined forces with us, setting up a Seedline work at the Alert Academy in Spring, Texas where Bro. Burch is the chaplain. Bro. and Mrs. Burch have been a big help with presenting the ministry in the state of Texas and overseeing the Seedline works there. We thank the Lord for such a sweet couple with a real burden for the printing of God's Word!

The Lord has been so good these past 20 years. We want to say thank you to our supporters whether it's been through finances, hands-on labor or men who have donated their time, trucks and trailers for hauling Scripture. You have helped make this ministry what it is today. But, can I challenge you as it says in John 9:4, "I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work. ". I truly believe that time is getting short. We must keep on keeping on as there is still work to be done.

GOOD NEWS NEWSPAPER, CHURCH BIBLE PUBLISHERS



Several years ago, an ex-army man entered our printshop and I gave him a copy of the John-Romans Newspaper that we had been printing for quite some time. God really touched his heart and he has reprinted this paper many times over and has passed them out on and around military installations across the country. Many churches have helped him to prepare packets and to hand them out. To date, he has given out over 100,000 of these "little preachers" as he calls them. Most folks are very receptive to the newspaper style format and these can easily be inserted into a local newspaper or left in a doctor's office (with permission), auto repair shops, the laundromat or virtually anywhere people have to wait.



Recently, a friend of mine called and asked for a printing of 20,000 to be sent to the Batavia, NY area. These have been placed in the Penny Saver paper and went to nine surrounding communities. When my friend was in town, he walked into a business, and saw one laying on a desk. The man who had it was excited that the Gospel had gone to 20,000 souls in his immediate area! Praise the Lord for another tool to reach the lost with the Word of God in these trying times.

Praise our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ for the gift of salvation and allowing us to be involved in HIS MINISTRY!

These past few months have taken us many miles through Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri, Mississippi, Indiana and South Dakota. It's been a blessing to see the burden that pastors have in getting the Word of God to the missions field.

We are sorry to say that we had to postpone the September shipment for Thailand that was planned as part of the BEST Conference in Rogers, Arkansas. This is due to lack of availability of shipping containers. The COVID shutdown has affected so many areas of our nation. The ports lack the laborers to off load containers. As of now, we have plans to ship this container of Thai Scripture and a container of English for the Philippines as a part of our home church's missions conference on October 14th. Please pray that workers will return to unload ships so that containers will be available for us to load these two shipments. Souls are waiting!

We are currently working towards a project to provide Scripture for Missionary James Ruckman for Ghana. Lord willing this container will be loaded in December containing Gospel of John and Romans, whole Bibles, Sunday School material, and personal goods. Praise the Lord we can assist with this request.

I am grateful for the Lord's great timing. His time is always perfect. I was delivering Scripture to northern Indiana when our truck (pulling the cargo trailer with four pallets of Scripture) decided to breakdown. Why praise the Lord for this??? It was 1500 miles from the engine warranty running out! The repair would have costs over \$3,000.00 if we would have had to pay for it ourselves. The extended warranty paid for all but \$500.00. Thank you Lord!

September 1st we celebrated twenty years as director of World Missions Bearing Precious Seed! With that said, I look forward to what the next twenty years of ministry will hold. I do know, "Where there is no vision the people perish", so I've been praying concerning the challenge for our ministry supporters. I want accomplishable goals, yet challenging ones. I believe the Lord would have us to purchase, print and collate 200 rolls of paper in the year 2022. This would yield about 3 million Scriptures. We already have the requests for these Scriptures in Thailand, Philippines, Central and South America, Nigeria and India. Please be in prayer concerning this challenge. Our annual "Rolls for Souls" campaign will begin this Thanksgiving and run through January 1st. We had a tremendous response last year but we would like to challenge our supporters to do even more this year in celebration of 20 years of ministry.

Thank you for your prayers! Thank you for your faithful support! Thank you for your labors in the Scripture Ministry! Millions have received the WORD OF GOD because of you!

Dennis Deneau Update:

Please write this verse somewhere and begin to think on it and pray with us about this verse. Isaiah 9:6 "The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light..." Already, this verse is true over and over again because of folks like you and the Lord working His many miracles in our ministry. But, God is not finished and He continues to have His hand on His work and directing our paths. We were impatiently waiting for our last doctor appointment so we could return to our meetings and our Scripture "hands-on" work in Missouri. The Lord had other plans, and our freezer "died". This delayed us a week again with getting a new freezer and then getting the old one looked at. During that time, an area church was having special meetings which we attended every night. We met a man who has been an Evangelist in India for over 30 years. He is begging for the Word of God, and we have almost a semi-truck load printed and our contact person over in India died, leaving us no one to receive the Scriptures! God had the "big picture" all planned out! This is OUR GOD, and these little miracles STILL give me chill bumps! Often, we fail to see our inconveniences as God's well designed plan! It's not about us; it's all about HIM!

Other great things did happen this summer, as I was able to reconnect with some pastors I had not spoken to in a long time. God is good to have kept these "old soldiers" serving the Lord! His mercies are new every morning.

What an amazing surprise we got when we returned to Missouri. (Not to have our Tennessee meeting cancelled due to flooding and Covid), but to see all that has gotten done in our Printshop area is exciting. The knocked out walls have made an unbelievable difference in the amount of storage area. The exterior door for the loading dock is fantastic! We still have much to rearrange, but our goal is to more than double the production in the next few months, for God's Glory. We are praying that the Lord will send us some extra workers for our Scripture ministry, and we know He can meet that need. He met a real need yesterday with 52 church folks going out on our first "Saturation Saturday" passing out fliers in the Community introducing our new Pastor! God can give us more helpers at the Printshop too! God has given us a stitcher-trimmer "automatic collator" and He can provide the folks to run it.

America is in trouble. Afghanistan is in trouble. The World is in trouble. But, folks are still getting saved around the world because of the Word of God! We need to keep our focus on our God! "For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still." Isaiah 9:12, 17, 21.

Our Mission Conference is coming in October. We have Scriptures finished to ship. We NEED a Container. Containers are scarce. But, God can provide. We say that our biggest need is always PAPER. But, that's only the physical need. Our "Always" needs are ALWAYS for: PRAYER-----PEOPLE-----PAPER!


